

Traxxion Showa Extended Fork Cap Housing Installation Instructions

- 1. Turn preload all the way out to the softest setting.
- 2. Hold stock fork cap upside down and remove the retaining spring clip (use small flat head screwdriver with sharp tip).
- 3. Use 19mm box end wrench or ratchet with 19mm socket to hold the blue preload adjuster from spinning and use 17mm wrench to unscrew the steel part with 2 flats from the blue preload adjuster (note this might be difficult due to loctite on the threads if needed use heat gun to heat the steel part).
- 4. Remove steel washer and push preload adjuster out of the housing.
- 5. Lube the o-rings and inside of the Traxxion extended fork cap housing where the washer touches with grease.
- 6. Insert the preload adjuster into the housing pushing it all the way in. Install steel washer.
- 7. MAKE SURE THAT THE SQUARE STEEL PLATFORM IS TURNED ALL THE WAY UP TO THE END WITH THE 2x17mm FLATS.
- 8. Screw the steel part back onto the preload adjuster and tighten to about 40-50 ft/lbs. Check the square steel platform you should be able to easily move it left and right slightly. If you can't then you missed step #7 and the platform bottomed out on the threads instead of the steel piece tightening up against the preload adjuster. Loosen the steel piece and correct this if necessary.
- 9. Install spring retaining clip back onto the preload adjuster and swap the o-ring from the old housing onto the new housing.
